F. Discussion - Activity Trip Chaperone

- 8 Superintendent Bob Moore talked about the districts activity trips and the number of
- 9 chaperones that are required for the trips. After comments from the Board on why the district has
- 10 a 1 to 10 ratio for chaperones, what are other districts doing about chaperones, if the ratio should
- be the same for day activity trips compared to overnight trips and if each situation should be on a
- 12 case to case basis, Mike Enzler made a motion to give the administration leeway to make
- yariances to the 1 to 10 ratio on school sponsored activity trips on a case by case basis. Penny
- 14 Bertram seconded the motion. All voted aye.

G. Out-of-District enrollment Philosophy

- Superintendent Bob Moore told the Board the administration was directed to come up with
- 17 a procedure or guideline for out of district enrollment. Bob told the Board the administration has
- 18 met and discussed this situation. Bob talked about the discussion the administration had and the
- 19 pros and cons on open enrollment at the district. Bob also talked about the items he has included
- 20 in their packet about enrollment. Bob asked the Board what direction or philosophy they would
- 21 like to go with open enrollment here at the district. After discussion and comments from the
- 22 Board on open enrollment, the pros and cons of open enrollment and closed enrollment, the
- 23 different kinds of impact out of district enrollment has on the district, the breakeven point of
- 24 hiring a new teacher due to increase in class sizes, updating the out of district enrollment form
- 25 with a deadline date on the form and the effect open enrollment has on the district budgets. Bob
- 26 thanked the Board for their input and told the Board the district will develop guidelines for out of
- 27 district students and he will present that to the Board in the near future.

C. Principals' Reports –Questions


- 20 Chairman Greg Trangmoe asked the Board if they have any questions for the principals.
