Bob talked about going out to get a temporary 45-day contract
with another bus company to transport the district students at this time and during that time go out and get bids for the rest of this year and the next several years. After comments from the Board and the audience on the 45 day temporary contract, if the district should meet with the bus drivers again to resolve the issue with the pay rate, if the district can rewrite their current contract without going out to bid and if the district can get a permanent contract with another bus contractor without going to bid. The Board took a break and the Superintendent called the school attorney to get the answers about going out to bid. Cathi called the meeting back to order and told the Board that Jennifer and Ben have been disconnected and they will not be able to vote on any motions made today. After more discussion on the direction the district needs to go in, the board decided to table this agenda item to gather more information from the bus contractors and to reschedule this meeting. Sarah Armijo made a motion to table this agenda item and to schedule a special board meeting for September 27, 2021 to get a resolution to the transportation situation. Kris McKoy seconded the motion. All voted aye.
